GRADUATE SCHOOL INCOMINGS

FIRST COMPACT SEMESTER OF MASTER IN ENERGY ECONOMICS

From October 28th till November 26th, seven Chilean engineers who study the Master Program in Energy Economics (MEE) spent a compact semester at Hochschule Offenburg. This Master program is a joint venture of Offenburg University with the Chilean Universidad Federico Santa María. Compared to ECM it has a stronger economic focus and is only offered in part-time. During the German study period the MEE students accomplished a tight program of lectures, company visits, workshops, presentations and exams. (UE)

FUNDING FOR INTERNATIONAL ALUMNI RETURNING TO HOME COUNTRY

The German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development offers a program which funds reintegration of employers or graduates when they return to their home countries. Eligible are nationals of transition- or less developed countries. One prerequisite is that you have worked or studied in Germany for at least two years. It is for example possible to apply for travel expenses or an additional allowance to the salary which will be paid between 6 and 24 months. 
RE-ACCREDITATION CME

GROUND BREAKING CEREMONY & MI ANNIVERSARY

On Thursday November 23rd, 2006 the ground-breaking ceremony for the new building took place at the Hochschule Offenburg. Prime Minister Günther H. Oettinger (CDU), the publisher Hubert Burda and the mayor of the city of Offenburg Edith Schreiner were present. The new building is going to be finished in 2008 and extends over a surface of 2800 m². The costs of the project amount to 9.7 million €. The ceremony was rounded off by the opening of the art exhibition „Interdependenzen“, initiated by two MI (Media & Information Technology) graduates: Markus Joos and Daniel Klotz. Their multimedia installation „Sensorama “ consisted out of a 72 sqm accessible area, surrounded by projections.

On the occasion of the 10th anniversary of the study program MI a grand opening an exhibition took place on campus. Posters, animations and the best films of the past years were presented. A special highlight was the screening of awarded animated movies Helden von Bern "and „Helden 06 “ (VH)

INTERNATIONAL EVENING 2006

Approximately 200 visitors (students, staff, members of the senior service and interested citizens) joined the 15th International Evening of the Graduate School on November 20th, 2006.
