DESCRIPTION

VML Summer School is a two-week unique experience to enjoy Mediterranean Lifestyle, our healthy and friendly way of living. Students will improve their academic competences through daily lectures in Arts & Culture, Science & Technology and Health & Nutrition.

INTENDED OUTCOMES

EVENT STRUCTURE

LECTURE 1

Group A. Arts & Culture

Mediterranean identity and heritage

TRAINING COURSES

IT Training: Applied IT Tools for University Staff

This intensive five-hour course will focus in two main areas:

- 1. Awareness of Internet hidden risks, stressing on the user's privacy.
- 2. Presentation creating skills. Widening the framework beyond the traditional presentations, introducing new tools.
