§ 6 Termination of the contract

- 1. During the probation period, the contract may be terminated by either party in writing at any time and without observing a notice period.
- 2. After the probation period, the contract may be terminated
- a) by either party for an important reason without observing a notice period
- b) by the Intern with a notice period of four weeks if they wish to discontinue their education.

The termination must be in writing and state the reasons for the termination.

§ 7 Vacation / minimum working days

The Intern is not entitled to vacation. According to § 4 (2) of the Study and Examination Regulations of the University, the required presence at the internship location is a minimum of 95 working days.

§ 8 Certification of the internship

Upon completion or discontinuation of the training, the Company will issue a certificate to the Intern.

§ 9 Settlement of disputes

In all disputes arising from this contract, an amicable settlement involving the University and the Chamber of Commerce and Industry is to be pursued before resorting to the courts.
